Keep the family entertained all day with a range of attractions whatever the weather. The Splash Park is one of the biggest in the region with water jets, sprays and cannons. Remember to bring a towel!

Get the kids to burn off some more energy in the play areas or try one of the attractions; bouncing on trampolines, riding the swing boats, board the miniature railway, a friendly game of adventure golf, enjoy a ride on the carousel or try the indoor play area if it's pouring down. We also have a Changing Places toilet available. Charges apply to some attractions - please see map icons.



MAKE A SPLASH You can be certain to get soaked at our splash park. Children love running through the interactive water jets, sprays and cannons and getting dunked under the fill and spill bucket! Tickets available from the kiosk (see map).



NATURAL ADVENTURE PLAY AREA Zoom along the zip wire, build dens, play games and build sandcastles. Brave the heights of the climbing frame and speed down the slide.
